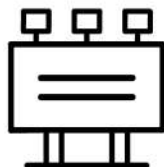

AI will make us more human! And a better one.

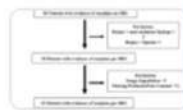

BONE PIT


Imaging Achilles tendon repair.

- ❖ Tissue turnover in the Achilles tendon is a very slow process that can be defined as “bradytrophic”. Tendon core is formed during height growth and is essentially not renewed thereafter.
- ❖ Tendon repair takes place in a centripetal direction (i.e., from the peripheral tissue towards the central zone) . **Doughnut metaphor**. Red area - Zone of disorganization of the tendon after tenorrhaphy ; Blue area - Zone of the tendon formed by aligned fibrillar structure.

Progressive centralization of T2/STIR hyperintense signal area

19.3 ± 11.3 months after Achilles tendon tenorrhaphy, in 30.7% of patients there is still a hyperintensity area present equal to 9.5 ± 10.2% of the tendon CSA

Decrease of at least 70% in the area or volume of hyperintensity or complete Doughnut appearance before return to play, is not associated with re-injury.

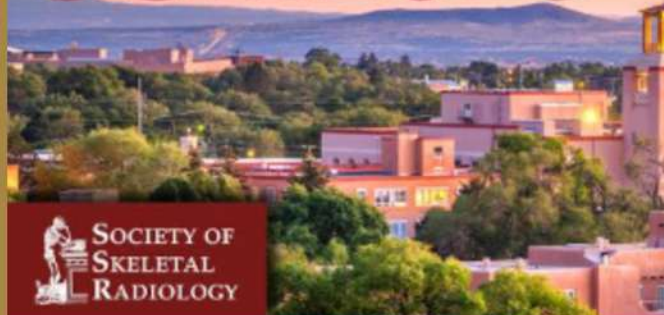
